Opening Prayer

Symbolum Apostolorum

Credo in Deum Patrem omnipotentem, Creatorem caeli et terrae. Et in Jesum Christum, Filium eius unicum, Dominum nostrum, qui conceptus est de Spiritu Sancto, natus ex Maria Virgine, passus sub Pontio Pilato, crucifixus, mortuus, et sepultus, descendit ad infernos, tertia die resurrexit a mortuis, ascendit ad caelos, sedet ad dexteram Dei Patris omnipotentis, inde venturus est iudicare vivos et mortuos. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of Grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the Fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and in the hour of our death. Amen.

Pater Aeterne

Pater aeterne, offero tibi Corpus et Sanguinem, animam et divitatem dilectissimi Filii Tui, Domini nostri, Jesu Christi, in propitiatione pro peccatis nostris et totius mundi.

Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your most beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

Pro Dolorosa

Pro dolorosa Eius passione, miserere nobis et totius mundi.

For the Sake of His Sorrowful Passion

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Sancte Deus

Sanctus Deus, Sanctus Fortis, Sanctus Immortalis, miserere nobis et totius mundi.

Holy God

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy upon us and on the whole world.


Oratio Finalis

Closing Prayer



How to Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet



Step 1: Pray **Signum Crucis** on the Crucifix.

Step 2: Pray **Oratio Incipiens** on the first bead.



Step 3: Pray **Pater Noster** on the second bead, **Ave Maria** on the third bead, and **Symbolum Apostolorum** on the fourth bead.

Step 4: Begin the first decade with **Pater Aeterne** and then pray ten **Pro Dolorosas**.

Step 5: Begin the second decade with **Pater Aeterne** and then pray ten **Pro Dolorosas**.

Step 6: Begin the third decade with **Pater Aeterne** and then pray ten **Pro Dolorosas**.

Step 7: Begin the fourth decade with **Pater Aeterne** and then pray ten **Pro Dolorosas**.

Step 8: Begin the fifth decade with **Pater Aeterne** and then pray ten **Pro Dolorosas**.

Step 9: After the fifth decade, conclude with **Sancte Deus**.

Step 10: Pray **Oratio Finalis** and **Signum Crucis** to finish the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
